

Water Recycling System Augmentation Stage 1

Project Description:	Council has received a subsidy from the State Government to augment the Yeppoon recycled water system. Stage 1 works will include duplication of the recycled water main from the treatment plant to Millroy Drive to increase system capacity and to protect the quality of the recycled water from the upgraded treatment plant. Additional water storage will also be provided to ensure sufficient recycled water is available to customers.
Reasons for Project:	The upgraded treatment plant will produce recycled water of a higher quality, suitable for a greater variety of uses. This project will ensure that the improved quality of the recycled water supplied will be maintained and will enable an increased quantity of recycled water to be supplied.
Benefits of Project:	To maximise the use of the high quality recycled water produced from the treatment plant and meet the needs of recycled water customers.
Estimated Total Cost:	\$2.7M
