

SCHEDULE 5 – DESIGN STANDARDS FOR COMMUNITY SAFETY

Column 1 Community Safety Element	Column 2 Standard
Surveillance <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Building Design ▶ Night lighting ▶ Landscaping 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ No concealed or recessed openings; ▶ Avoid blind corners involving a change in direction of 75° or greater; ▶ Movement corridors no longer than 200 metres; and ▶ Building entries and exits are limited and located at the front of the building (except for controlled emergency exits). ▶ Night lighting designed and installed in accordance with <i>Australian Standard AS1158: Public Lighting Code</i>. ▶ Planting of species with clear trunks to a height of 1.8 metres and low ground covers less than 1.0 metre in height.
Boundary Definition	Integration of the following features into site design: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ fencing; ▶ changes in surface finishes; ▶ landscape treatments; and ▶ clear premises identification such as premises numbering or appropriate signage.
Construction Materials and Finishes	Use of vandal resistant surface treatments (i.e., paint and stain resistant finishes).
