Are your pets' details up to date?

It is important to ensure your pet's registration details are up to date in case we need to contact you should your pet become lost, injured or involved in an accident.

Please check the following registration details for your pet are correct:

-  Residential or postal address
-  Telephone number
-  Email address
-  Discount eligibility
-  Microchip number
-  Has your pet been de-sexed since last registration?
-  Has your pet passed away or been sold?

These details can be updated by contacting our Customer Service Team on **4913 5000** or call into any Customer Service Centre and filling out the appropriate form.

Your registration will be cancelled if you have left Livingstone Shire, and you will need to re-register with the Council in your new area. Remember to also notify your microchip provider of your pet's change of details.

Pet Registration

The Animal Management (Cats & Dogs) Act 2008 and Council's Local Law No. 2 Animal Management 2015 mandates domestic animal (cats and dogs) registration. In promoting responsible pet ownership a key initiative for animal registration is to enable prompt identification of an owner ensuring the safe return of cats and dogs.

Why register your cat or dog?

Registration makes it easier for lost cats and dogs to be identified and reunited with their owners. Registration also helps us provide animal management services and facilities that help keep your pets, the community and the environment safe.

How do I register my cat or dog?

Call in to one of our Customer Service Centres to:

 Complete a registration form for your cat or dog

 Ensure the registration form is accompanied by:

- Registration fee,
- If it is desexed, a signed veterinary surgeon's certificate stating that it has been desexed, and
- Your pension card (if applicable).
