

Yeppoon Precinct Principal Cycle Network Project

Project Description:	Construction of concrete pathways and associated works on Appleton Drive from Vaughan Street to ANZAC Parade, Yeppoon.
Reasons for Project:	This construction project will include new pathways, new pedestrian crossings, streetlighting upgrades, underground stormwater upgrades and the relocation of bus stops.
Benefits of Project:	Provision of a higher level of safety for pedestrians, cyclists and motorists.
Estimated Total Cost:	\$1,537,960
Commencement Date:	August 2025
Duration of Project:	9 months

Public Consultation:	Notice of works issued to businesses and residents in the area, traffic control signage will be erected and direct communication with properties that will have driveway access restrictions.
Potential Interruptions:	Various interruptions to normal traffic flow during various stages of the works. Interruptions to normal traffic flow will include: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Lane and road closures with detours provided• Reduced speeds through work areas• Short term single lane closures to manoeuvre equipment and machinery• Short term part lane closures during some excavations• Barrier fencing restricting pedestrian access to various areas

The site staff will be able to assist with alternative access arrangements on a day-to-day basis.
