Key Message(s)	Presentation by Alderson and Associates Landscape Architects – Nick highlighted the uniqueness of the site and council foresight with what he feels is the potential to become a memorial park – ie nature walks, columbarium etc.
Feedback Summary:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Site supports Livingstone Shire Council’s long term vision regarding future road corridor connections for Mulambin Road, Clayton Road, Coucoms Road and thus why intersection is larger than what would normally be needed. • Minimal impact to neighbouring properties/visual is expected – site is 100ha and vegetation value is extremely high. Vision is to build roads, tracks or structures around existing vegetation/trees/waterways etc not the usual alternate • Concept Plan is largely around Stage 1 – future stages will occur based on funds and population growth etc. Expected that this will set the Livingstone Shire up for at least 100 years and offer a variety of options for the community. • Plots will be double depth and it is hoped first funeral could be early 2019. Substantial completion date Dec 2018.
