What's the season look like?

La Niña is under way in the tropical Pacific

The Bureau of Meterology ENSO Outlook has been raised to LA NIÑA.

Key atmospheric and oceanic indicators of the El Niño-

Southern Oscillation (ENSO) show an established La Niña. Models indicate this La Niña event may peak during the spring and return to neutral conditions early in 2023. La Niña events increase the chances of above-average rainfall for northern and eastern Australia during spring and summer.



Mitigation Works

HQPlantations prescribed burning program Stack burning has commenced within the Maryvale (Mapes Road) and Brampton Logging area (north of Byfield township). Operations will continue through until the end of October 2022. Aged Care Specialist Officers

You, your family or a representative may be able to speak to one of our Aged Care Specialist Officers. This is a free service available in some of our service centres to help you with your aged care matters. They can help you by:

- providing in-depth information on the different types of aged care services
- checking if you're eligible for government-funded services and making a referral for an aged care assessment
- providing financial information about aged care services
- helping you appoint a representative for My Aged Care
- connecting you to local support services.
