Livingstone Shire Council's Youth Services provide a range of services to young people (12 – 25 years) within Livingstone Shire to increase young people's opportunities within their community.

What we offer

Information, Advice and Referral – Youth Services can assist young people to find the support they seek locally whether it be related to school, housing, relationships, boredom or stress. We can connect young people with sports and recreation activities and/or arts and cultural opportunities and/or volunteering opportunities in the community.

One on one support

Youth Services can provide individual case management for young people who would like to further develop their life skills, coping skills, social skills and self-esteem, are 12-18 years, living in Yeppoon or Emu Park and who are at risk of disconnection.

Community events

Youth Services organises a variety of opportunities within the community that appeal to young people to reduce boredom and to increase connection between young people and their community.

Alternative Learning Space

The Alternative Learning Space, at the Community Centre in Yeppoon is a flexible access point for students who wish to attend to their studies as negotiated with the Capricornia School of Distance Education. It is supported by Council's Youth Services Program, PCYC/Youth Connections, the Capricornia School of Distance Education and Yeppoon State High School.
