DOGS ON GREAT KEPPEL ISLAND!

You and your best friend(s) are off to Great Keppel Island! There are regulations regarding what you need to do to help ensure that your trip to Great Keppel is safe and enjoyable for everyone.

The welfare of your dog is your responsibility - remember that its behaviour may change in unfamiliar environments.

ON THE FERRY:

To ensure the safety and comfort of all passengers, please keep the following in mind when travelling with your four-legged friend:

- Ensure your dog is on a lead and if appropriate wearing a muzzle or in an enclosed carrier;
- Remain outside the ferry cabin and maintain control of your pet at all times;
- Carry waste bags and clean up and take with you any mess your dog makes while on board; and
- Travel with a maximum of two dogs at a time

If you have any concerns, please discuss them with ferry crew before boarding.

ON THE ISLAND:

- You are able to exercise your dog before 8am and after 4pm. Outside of these hours, dogs must be on a leash;
- Keep a leash with you at all times;
- Stay with your dog to ensure effective control;
- Monitor your dog's behaviour towards other people and dogs; and
- Always clean up after your pet or you could be issued with an on the spot fine

As we also share our beaches with sea turtles and an abundance of shoreline birds, using designated areas correctly and keeping your dog on a leash, ultimately means you and your dog are helping us to also protect the environment.

Being a responsible pet owner means that you care about the actions of your dog - and we LOVE that!
