## **CODE OF CONDUCT**

Being a Youth Action Group member is an opportunity to represent young people in your community and promote the issues that are important to them. Your behaviour as a member of the Youth Action Group should uphold Council's Values and Behaviours and enhance the reputation of Council and the group.



# **Participation**

Council recognises that individuals have different commitments outside of the Youth Action Group. As long as this is discussed with the Action Group Coordinator, arrangements can be made to take time out from activities.

If a Youth Action Group member does not participate in meetings, emails and other activities, a review of that person's commitment may take place if no acknowledgement is made. If a Youth Action Group member wishes to resign or take a break from the group, notification in writing to the Action Group Coordinator is required.

### Behaviour towards each other

Youth Action Group members should treat each other with respect, honesty, fairness, sensitivity and dignity. Youth Action Group members are expected to accommodate and respect different opinions and perspectives, insight and knowledge and to manage interpersonal disagreements by rational debate. You must not behave towards any other person in a way that could be perceived as intimidating, overbearing or bullying. As a Youth Action Group member you are required to use appropriate and courteous language in your communications to all and promote respect between individuals and avoid any discomfort.

Any complaint, unresolved problem or serious dispute that involves Youth Action Group members is to be brought to the Action Group Coordinator for resolution. Council reserves the right to reassess membership of any young person if Council believes the young person has acted inappropriately.
