

Appendix 2 – Table of amendments

The following tables identify the original Livingstone Planning Scheme 2018 and amendments that have commenced.

Editor's note - For this planning scheme, an amendment of the planning scheme document (i.e., an amendment to any part of the planning scheme other than an amendment to any map) results in a change to the Document Version reference identified in Table A2.2 below and in the footnotes of the document. For this planning scheme, it does not result in a change to the Map Version references that are identified on maps and references which are listed in the Map Indexes contained within Schedule 2 and Schedule 3 of the planning scheme. If an amendment results in a change to any map, then a change will be made to the Map Version references identified on the relevant map(s) and the references that are listed in the Map Indexes contained within Schedule 2 and Schedule 3 of the planning scheme. For example, if five amendments occur to the planning scheme (other than mapping), the Document Version reference will likely be 'Version 5', however, as there are no changes to any maps as part of the amendments, the Map Version references will remain as 'Version 1'. If a mapping amendment affects only one map, then only that map will have a new Map Version reference. If a mapping amendment affects an overlay shown on a series of overlay maps, then all maps in the series will likely have a new Map Version reference.
