



Lot history

The lot was created in 1982.

- Lifestyle lot.
 - Bushfire hazard
 - Biodiversity wetlands, waterways and vegetation
 - Topography of the site

Constraints were identified in the 2005 Planning scheme

- Planning Scheme minimum lot size
 - 1991 –10 hectares and potential for 1 hectare family subdivision
 - 1991 (amended 28/01/1994) 10 hectares only with removal of 1 hectare family subdivision provision
 - 2005 10 hectares
 - 2018 10 hectares




Bushfire Hazard Overlay



- Risk of entrapment for occupants and emergency services with only one lawful vehicle access to and from the site.
- Access ways must be maintained to a sufficient standard. For 640 metres this is not reasonably achievable.
- Emergency services personnel place their lives at unacceptable risk during disaster response and recovery in the event of a bushfire.
- Creation of an addition lot within an area identified as bushfire hazard places additional persons and property at unnecessary risk.




Biodiversity Overlay – Habitat and Vegetation

Adverse impacts on the ecological function with the introduction of foreign matter (associated with the construction and maintenance of a residential uses)


Biodiversity Overlay – Habitat and Vegetation



North to South link




Biodiversity Overlay – Stream order

The subject site is located slightly outside the study area however, the investigation indicates the site would be significantly impacted in 1% Annual Exceedance Probability flood event.



Summary

The proposal does not meet the Acceptable, Performance or Overall outcomes outlined in the Strategic framework, Reconfiguring a Lot code, Development Works Code, Biodiversity Overlay Code and Bushfire Hazard Overlay Code.

Based on the balanced assessment undertaken, the application is **not** supported by Officers.
