Usage category	Conditions
Private gardens (Single dwellings, duplexes and multi-unit developments)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ Irrigation systems and sprinklers banned.</li> <li>◆ No watering of existing turf/lawns allowed.</li> <li>◆ New turf by limited exemption.</li> <li>◆ Hand-held watering only permitted during 7am - 9am and 4pm-6pm.                             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ Odd numbered properties - Tuesday, Thursday &amp; Saturday</li> <li>◆ Even numbered properties - Wednesday, Friday &amp; Sunday</li> <li>◆ No watering permitted on Mondays</li> </ul> </li> <li>◆ Exemption required otherwise.</li> <li>◆ No restrictions for recycled water or bore.</li> </ul>
Car & boat washing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ By bucket during the times permitted for hand watering.</li> <li>◆ Exemption required otherwise.</li> </ul>
Swimming pools – existing	◆ Restrictions apply - filling allowed during hand watering time.
Swimming pools – new	◆ No filling permitted.
Driveways, footpaths, houses	◆ No washdown permitted.
Commercial businesses	◆ No restrictions apply for businesses that use potable water outside as part of their core business (eg: builders, dog washers, bricklayers, concrete cutters, pressure cleaners, landscapers, car and boat detailers).
Bowling greens, golf greens only, turf cricket pitches	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ Restrictions as for private gardens.</li> <li>◆ Exemption required otherwise.</li> <li>◆ No restrictions for recycled water or bores.</li> </ul>
Commercial nurseries	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ Restrictions as for private gardens.</li> <li>◆ Exemption required otherwise.</li> <li>◆ No restrictions for recycled water or bores.</li> </ul>
Council parks, gardens & sports grounds	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ Restrictions as for private gardens for potable water.</li> <li>◆ No restrictions for recycled water or bores.</li> </ul>
Schools	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ Restrictions as for private gardens.</li> <li>◆ Exemption required otherwise.</li> <li>◆ No restrictions for recycled water or bores.</li> </ul>
Public health purposes	◆ No restrictions apply.
Development sites	◆ No use of potable water allowed.
Stock watering	◆ No restrictions apply.
Beach showers	◆ Beach showers connected.
